PREMIER'S PERSPECTIVE

The youth is the hardest hit designated group in our society in the scourge of high unemployment rate. This perspective is evidenced by the latest StatsSA figures in which 4.8 million youth is unemployed. Mpumalanga is not spared from the scourge, as corroborated by the ????? unemployed youth, presented by StatsSA.

We take pride in the implementation of the Mpumalanga Youth Development Fund (MYDF) which seeks to cushion the youth against the grinding effects of unemployment. The fund is a public declaration that we are prepared to walk an extra mile, irrespective of our limited financial constraints, to fight the cause of the youth against unemployment, by funding youth-led business enterprises.

Since the public declaration in the State of the Province Address (SoPA) in the 2020/21 financial year, the results are showing, as evidenced in this booklet. Through the fund, several youth-led business enterprises, are supported financially as beneficiaries, in areas, not limited to, mining, farming, transportation, construction, and waste management.

Part of the criteria for supported business establishment is job creation. We are satisfied

that since the fund was established several job opportunities have been created, thus flattening the high unemployment curve which was exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic. We note that these establishments prioritize the local youth for job opportunities. We have the strongest conviction that history will be on our side as a Provincial Government which initiated a radical intervention in support of the youth.

In the disbursement process of funds, we can assure you, as a tax payer, that we have spared no effort, through a fine tooth comb, in ensuring that legitimate companies are paid. A committee, comprised of officials from the Office of the Premier, Provincial Treasury and the Mpumalanga Economic Growth Agency (MEGA) was established to adjudicate the process, leading up to the payment. Furthermore a thorough monitoring of the business is undertaken.

At the time of printing this booklet, sixty (60) business enterprises benefitted through payments of funds across the three Districts. While government explores market opportunities for the enterprises in the farming sector, we implore you to support them for sustainability.
