Today, in his honor, we are unveiling the Reception Area of the Academy and we are making plans that on the 27th of October 2017 on his birthday this Academy will from that day onwards be known as OR Tambo Mathematics, Science and Technology Academy.

We have to do this because OR Tambo's course resonates with our quest to promote the intake and pass rate of Mathematics and Physical Science.
