## MEDIA ALERT – PRESS CONFRENCE 16 NOVEMBER 2010

Since the MEC and National Minister of education have neglected to amicably address the issue on matric certificates outstanding since 2008, the DA will host a press conference to divulge the reasons why the departments are unable to comply.

In the past, DA Provincial Leader, A Benadie has written to the MEC on several occasions requesting her to resolve this issue. The MEC has repeatedly denied that any problems exist and has as recently as 10 November 2010 stated that "former learners whose certificates were already at their former schools at the time of the enquiry." The DA has established that this is not the case and that many Learners and students certificates are still outstanding.
