KAMHLUSHWA PRIMARY SCHOOL**

The MEC for Education, Mrs. Reginah Mhaule will conduct an inspection on the construction of the KaMhlushwa Primary School as per the following schedule:

Date : 20 December 2010 (Monday)
Time : 09H00
Venue : KaMhlushwa (Ehlanzeni District)

The site handover for the construction of KaMhlushwa Primary School was done on 22November 2010 and the school will be constructed in **two** phases.

Phase one will cover the construction of Grade R Centre: 1, Classrooms: 16, Admin block, Toilets: 24, Fence, Electricity and Water and is expected to end by 10 January 2011.

Phase two includes a kitchen, ramps & rails, three sports grounds, car park and will end in September 2011.

This is a **R42 million** project which will be implemented on a fast track mode.

The construction of KaMhlushwa Primary School is an endeavour to alleviate overcrowding and to enhance teaching and learning.

Learners who will attend at this school are currently placed at Hoest Primary School in makeshift structures. The construction of this school will be a huge relief for the people of Sidlamafa Village.
