SUBJECT: LAST CHANCE FOR QEDIBANGA LEARNERS

The Mpumalanga Department of Education urges all candidates that have registered to write (Qedibanga) May/June Examinations to ensure that they have all relevant information regarding these examinations and most importantly to prepare to write.

Qedibanga learners are those who wrote their Senior Certificate examinations prior 2007 and needed to write one or two subjects in order to get a Senior Certificate.

The May/June Examinations will commence on 03 May to 24 June 2011. **21 635** candidates registered to write in **213** Q'ebanga centres.

Subjects that were supposed to be written on the **18 May 2011** (i.e. IsiZulu, IsiSwati;SiXhosa First Language HG p2(Literature) have been scheduled to be written on **06 June 2011** in the morning due to Local Municipal Elections on that day.

“I want to take this time to encourage all candidates who have registered to write these examinations to take advantage of this opportunity and participate meaningfully in these examinations. This will be the last chance given to them to write in order to get their Senior Certificate” says MEC Reginah Mhaule.

Candidates should collect their admission letters at the allocated centres or Circuit Offices which they should at all time bring along to the Examination Centres and together with Identity documents.
