Land & Buildings:

The favourable variance is due to the closure of a regional office in Secunda.

Professional and Special Services:

The saving is attributed to the Riverside Government Complex security service which was taken over by the Department of Public Works, Roads and Transport.

Transfer Payments:

The favourable variance is attributed to grants not paid to Traditional Authorities due to disputes regarding Chieftainship.

Miscellaneous:

The unfavourable variance is attributed to Provincial events that were budgeted for but were later changed to National events without additional funds received from National
